Lisa Iezzoni, MD is a professor at Harvard University. Dr. Iezzoni has spent more than two decades conducting health services research focusing on three primary areas: risk adjustment methods for predicting cost and clinical outcomes of care; use of administrative data for assessing health care quality; and health care experiences and outcomes of persons with disabilities. After spending 16 years as Co-Director of Research in the Division of General Medicine and Primary Care at Boston's Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, Dr. Iezzoni joined the MIHP as Associate Director in 2006. She is currently serving as Director of MIHP.

Dr. Iezzoni has led numerous research grants with funding from the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, National Institutes of Health, the Health Care Financing Administration, The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, and other private foundations. An internationally recognized expert in risk adjustment, she has edited *Risk Adjustment for Measuring Health Care Outcomes*, now in its third edition. Dr. Iezzoni has also published numerous original articles, editorials, and commentaries in major medical and health services research journals.
